



We love our volunteers!


We had **125 volunteers** in 2022, **serving 5,337** hours in clinic. We could not do our work without them!

IMPACT

Esmeralda and her husband Gerardo came to America from Mexico seeking a better life. After suffering a stroke in November 2021, Esmeralda was in need of a primary doctor for follow up care. Since they had no insurance, they were referred to Borland Free Clinic.

Our team of doctors were able to get Esmeralda the medication, Physical Therapy and nutrition plan she needed to start her recovery. When Esmeralda experienced a subsequent stroke, she was left wheelchair bound. After just a few visits to the clinic, everyone was surprised to see her walk again on her own.







LOOKING AHEAD TO 2023 (AND BEYOND)


