With humility and gratitude we are excited to share this update on the work and impact of Borland Free Clinic.

2023 was a year unlike any other—literally. Over the course of the past year, Borland Free Clinic saw more patients, over more visits, for more unique service offerings, while utilizing more volunteers and partners than ever before in its brief history. In short, Borland Free Clinic is growing as it continues to live into its **mission** of bringing hope and healing to vulnerable people in our community as an expression of Christ's love, and **vision** that every person in the South Metro Portland area has the blessing of access to quality health care that is respectful and compassionate.
