# Executive Director's Address

Friends of Borland Free Clinic,

With humility and gratitude we are excited to share this update on the work and impact of Borland Free Clinic.

2023 was a year unlike any other—literally. Over the course of the past year, Borland Free Clinic saw more patients, over more visits, for more unique service offerings, while utilizing more volunteers and partners than ever before in its brief history. In short, Borland Free Clinic is growing as it continues to live into its **mission** of bringing hope and healing to vulnerable people in our community as an expression of Christ's love, and **vision** that every person in the South Metro Portland area has the blessing of access to quality health care that is respectful and compassionate.

Additionally, 2023 saw the launch of the clinic's first ever capital campaign to fund the renovation and expansion of our clinic space so that we may provide health care in an enhanced, more dignified manner. Construction began in December 2023 and we are poised to open the new clinic space sometime during the spring of 2024.

Of course, none of this would be possible without the immense generosity of our volunteers, partners and donors, who together help us provide care at no cost to our patients.

As we look to 2024, which will see us move into our new space followed by an anticipated expansion of our hours and services, we are excited to take the next step in our clinic's history while continuing to offer excellent care to our neighbors.

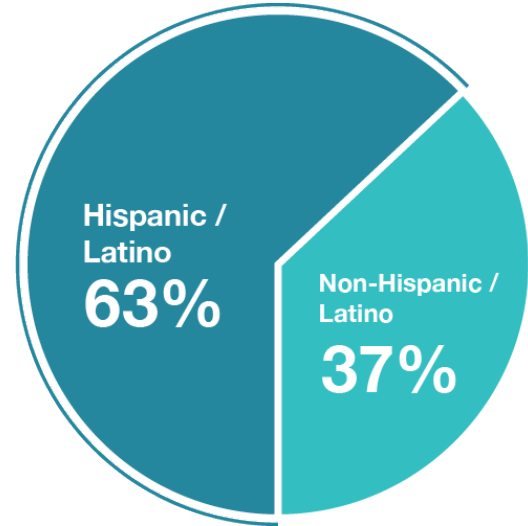

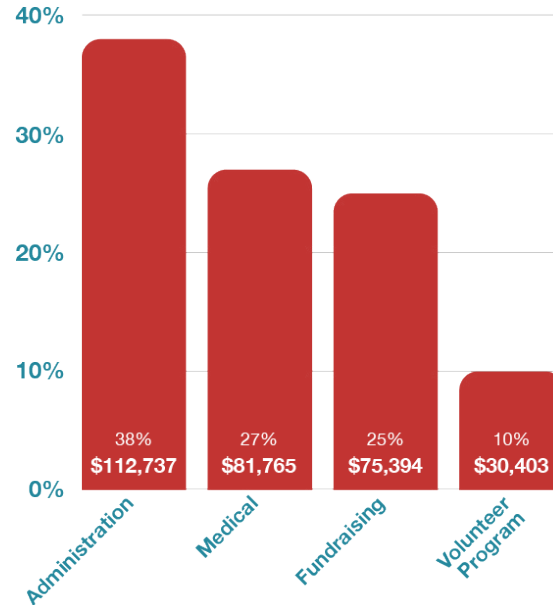


# 2023 Financials

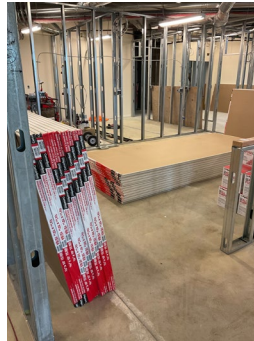
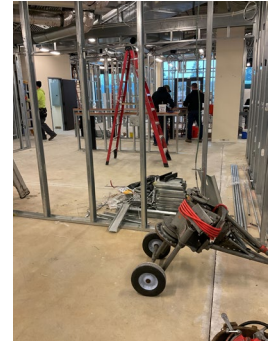
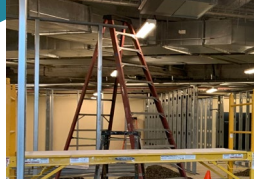
